

The University of St. Mary of the Lake, home of the major seminary of the Archdiocese of Chicago, is located in Mundelein, Illinois, approximately 35 miles north of O'Hare International Airport. Founded in 1921 by George Cardinal Mundelein, the University is situated on a 1000 acre wooded tract, complete with walking trails and a two hundred acre lake.

Facilities:

- o Private Rooms with individual bathrooms and linens provided
- o Chapel for daily Mass and prayer
- o Dining Hall adjacent to Residences and Conference Halls

Amenities Included in Conference Fees:

- o Return transportation to O'Hare International Airport. **PLEASE NOTE: The bus will leave at 11:00 pm on Friday, July 15. Please schedule any return flights no earlier than 2:00 pm if you plan to utilize this service. If you schedule an earlier flight, you will be responsible for return transportation to the airport**

Directions to the University of St. Mary of the Lake:

From O'Hare International Airport

Take the I-190 EAST ramp towards CHICAGO LOOP. Take the I-294 NORTH exit. Take I-294 NORTH/I-94 WEST (the Tri-state Tollway). Exit ILLINOIS ROUTE-176 (ROCKLAND RD.). Turn RIGHT onto 176/MAPLE AVE.

From North/Milwaukee

Take I-94 EAST towards CHICAGO/INDIANA. Exit at ILLINOIS ROUTE-21/MILWAUKEE AVE. Turn RIGHT (south) onto RT. 21/MILWAUKEE AVE. Turn RIGHT onto 176/MAPLE AVE.

From Chicago (and Midway Airport)

Take I-90 WEST/I-94 WEST/KENNEDY EXPY. Take I-94 WEST/EDENS EXPY toward Milwaukee. Take I-94 WEST toward Milwaukee (Tri-state Tollway). Exit ILLINOIS ROUTE 176 (ROCKLAND RD.). Turn RIGHT onto 176/MAPLE AVE.

From ROUTE 176 (MAPLE AVE.) continue for about three miles. Enter the Seminary main entrance on the RIGHT. Keep LEFT to the Center for Development in Ministry (CDM) parking.

Ground Transportation from O'Hare Airport and Midway Airport is available from Northshore Limo Service. **Please contact Northshore at 800-543-0037 for arrangements and reservations.**

All major rental car companies offer service from both airports. Parking is available on the Seminary Grounds free of charge.
